Life Journey Scholarship (3 x \$1000)

Mining Sector Scholarship (2x1000)

Scholarship for post-secondary students who demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the mining industry

- Student must be enrolled in a full time mining related program
- Write a brief statement of your interest in the Mining Industry. You should include any experience or knowledge of the mining industry.
- Must be in good standing with the institution
- What program have you chosen to take and why?

Health Field Scholarship (3x2000)

This scholarship is available for students presently enrolled full time in a health care program. Programs include but are not limited to those in medicine, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, mental health supports, etc.

- Please write a 250 word essay stating your reason for choosing a health care profession.
- Student demonstrate financial need
- Minimum grade point average of 70%

General Scholarship (6x1000)

This scholarship is available to a student who is currently enrolled in one of the following levels

- Level 1 – Certificate/Diploma
- Level 2- Undergraduate
- Level 3 – Masters
- Level 4 – Doctorate

- Submit a 500 word essay that describes your academic achievements and your motivation for pursuing a degree. Include your reasons for applying for this scholarship.
- Minimum grade point average of 70%

Certificate/Diploma Scholarship (3x1000)

This scholarship is to provide financial support to students in a certificate or diploma program.

- Submit a brief statement illustrating your intentions to further your education and your desire to succeed in your selected program.
- Minimum 70% Average

Business Scholarship (2x1500)

This scholarship is available for students who are currently enrolled in Business Administration, Business Management, Accounting, Commerce and/or other finance related programs.

- Submit a brief statement illustrating your intentions to further your education and your desire to succeed in your selected program.
- Minimum 75% Average

Grade 12 Completion Scholarship (4 x \$500)

- Student currently enrolled in Gr. 12
- Minimum grade point average of 70%
- Submit a short essay that lists your academic goals as well as your life goals.

Requirements

- Must provide copies of final marks, if required
- Demonstrate financial need
