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### 2024-2025 Scholarships

#### **Engineering Scholarship (2 x \$2000)**

This scholarship is awarded to two students who are either entering or currently enrolled full-time in an Engineering program. Each recipient will receive \$2,000, with an **additional \$1,000 granted upon successful completion of the current academic year in their Engineering degree**

- Please write a personal statement outlining your career goals and academic accomplishments in **Engineering** and how your degree program will help you achieve these goals.

#### **Project Management Scholarship (1 x \$1000)**

Scholarship for post-secondary students who demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the Project Management industry

- Student must be enrolled in a full time project management program
- Write a brief statement on your interest in this field and what are your career goals

#### **Mining Sector Scholarship (2x1500)**

Scholarship for post-secondary students who demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the mining industry

- Student must be enrolled in a full time mining related program
- Write a brief statement of your interest in the Mining Industry. You should include any experience or knowledge of the mining industry.

#### **Health Field Scholarship (3x1500)**

This scholarship is available for students presently enrolled full time in a health care program. Programs include but are not limited to those in medicine, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, mental health supports, etc.

- Student must be enrolled in a health related program
- Please write a brief statement stating your reason for choosing a health care profession and what are your career goals

### **General Scholarship (6x1000)**

This scholarship is available to a student who is currently enrolled in one of the following levels

- Level 1 – Certificate/Diploma
- Level 2- Undergraduate
- Level 3 – Masters
- Level 4 – Doctorate

- Submit a brief statement that describes your academic achievements and your motivation for pursuing a degree. Include your reasons for applying for this scholarship.

### **Certificate/Diploma Scholarship (3x1000)**

This scholarship is to provide financial support to students in a certificate or diploma program.

- Submit a brief statement illustrating your intentions to further your education and your desire to succeed in your selected program.

### **Business Scholarship (2x1500)**

This scholarship is available for students who are currently enrolled in Business Administration, Business Management, Accounting, Commerce and/or other finance related programs.

- Submit a brief statement illustrating your intentions to further your education and your desire to succeed in your selected program.

**Students will receive an additional \$1000 for completion of the current year in their Business Degree**

### **Grade 12 Completion Scholarship (4 x \$500)**

- Student currently enrolled in Gr. 12
- Must be attending Mistawasis Nêhiyawak High School
- Submit a short essay that lists your academic goals as well as your life goals.

### **85% or Higher Average (4x1000)**

This scholarship is available for students that have an 85% or higher average based on the 2024-2025 academic year

- Student must submit a transcript demonstrating a minimum overall grade average of 85% on the most recent completed academic year
- Students must be enrolled in minimum 18 or more credit units for the 2024-2025 academic year

### **Education & Social Work Scholarship (2 x \$1,000)**

This scholarship is available to two students who are currently enrolled full-time in an Education or Social Work program. Each recipient will receive \$2,000.

- Must be a full-time student enrolled in an accredited Education or Social Work program.
- Demonstrate a commitment to supporting communities through education or social services.
- Submit a personal statement outlining your career goals, academic achievements, and how your chosen field will allow you to make a meaningful impact in your community.
